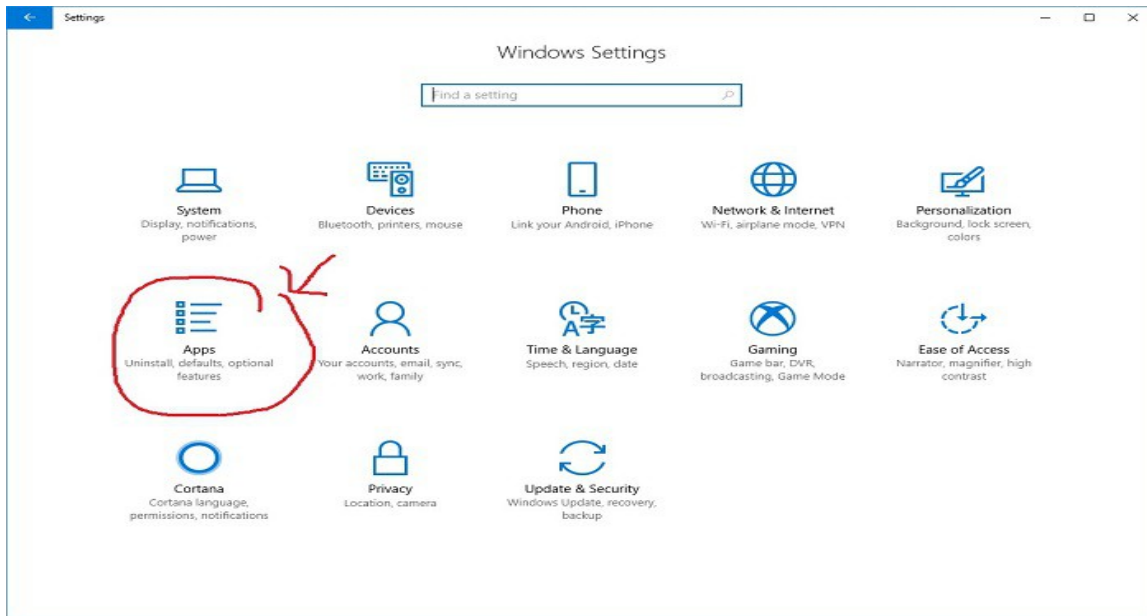
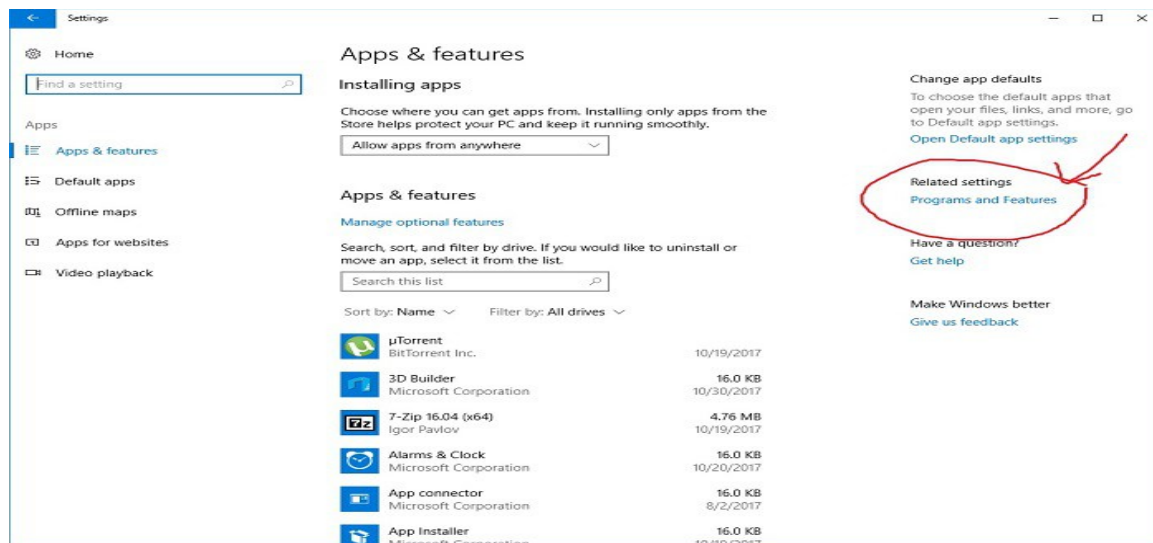


Enable SMB1 in Windows 10 Fall Creators Update (build 1709) to shared folder for RockBox

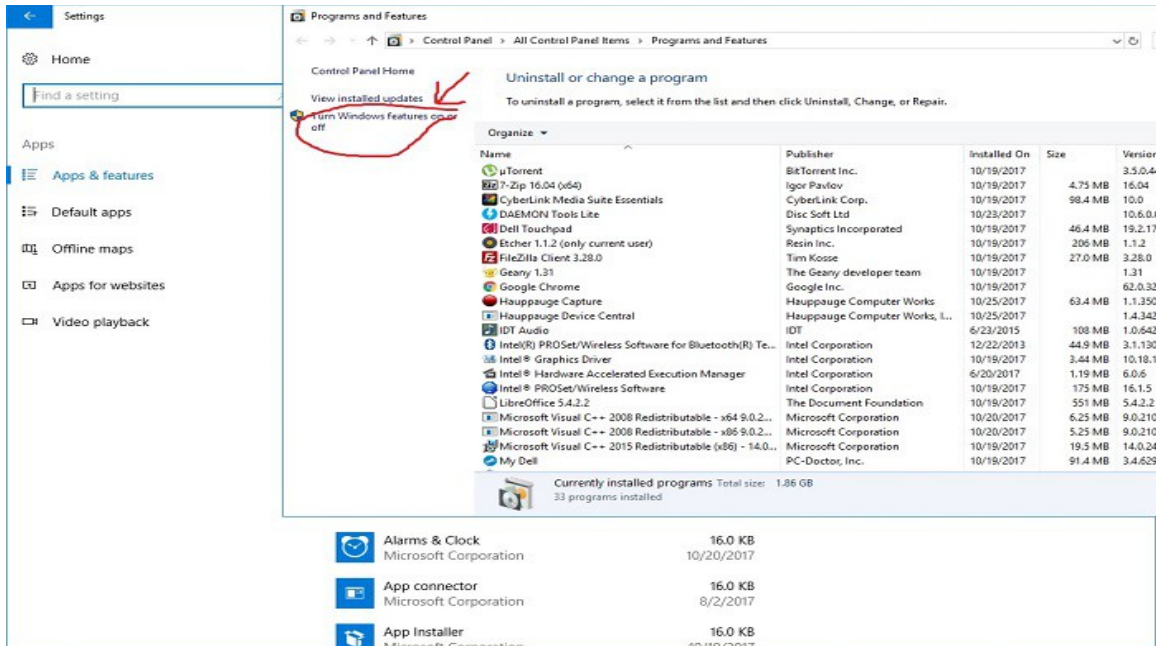
Step 1 : Go to Window Setting, Select Apps



Step 2 : Select the Programs and Features

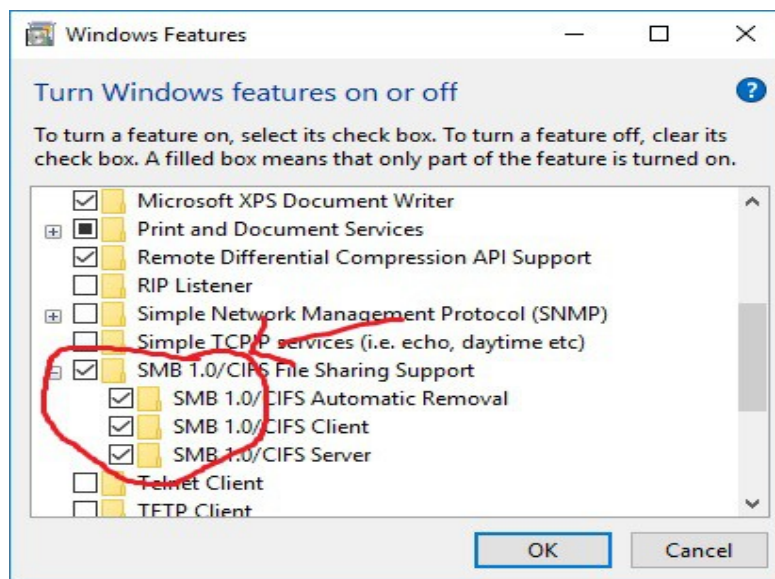


Step 3 : Select “Turn Windows features on or off”



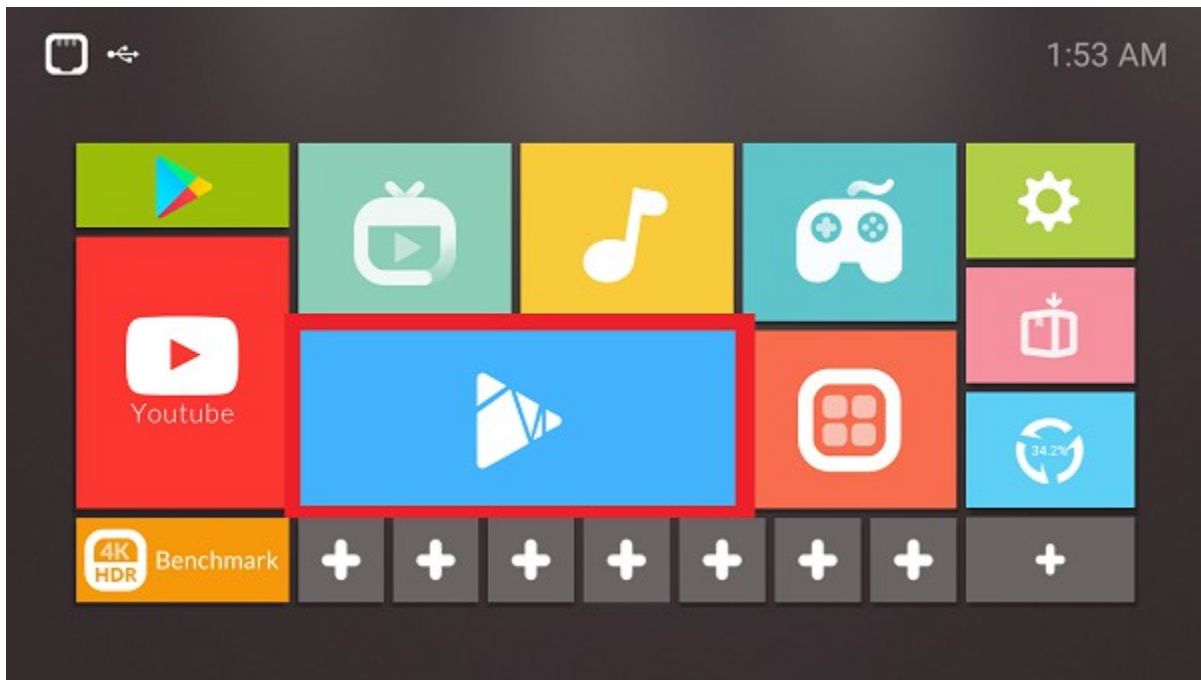
Step 4 : Make sure you TICK the 4 options :

- SMB 1.0/CIFS Server

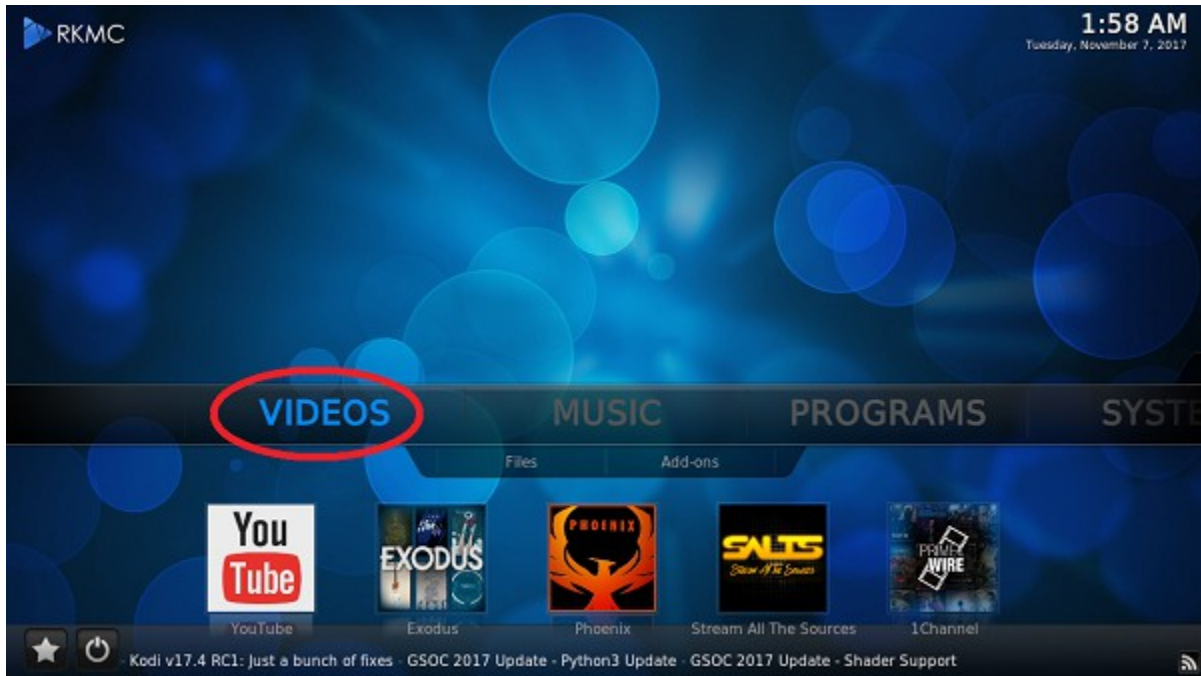


Step 5 : Access to Network share via RKMC :

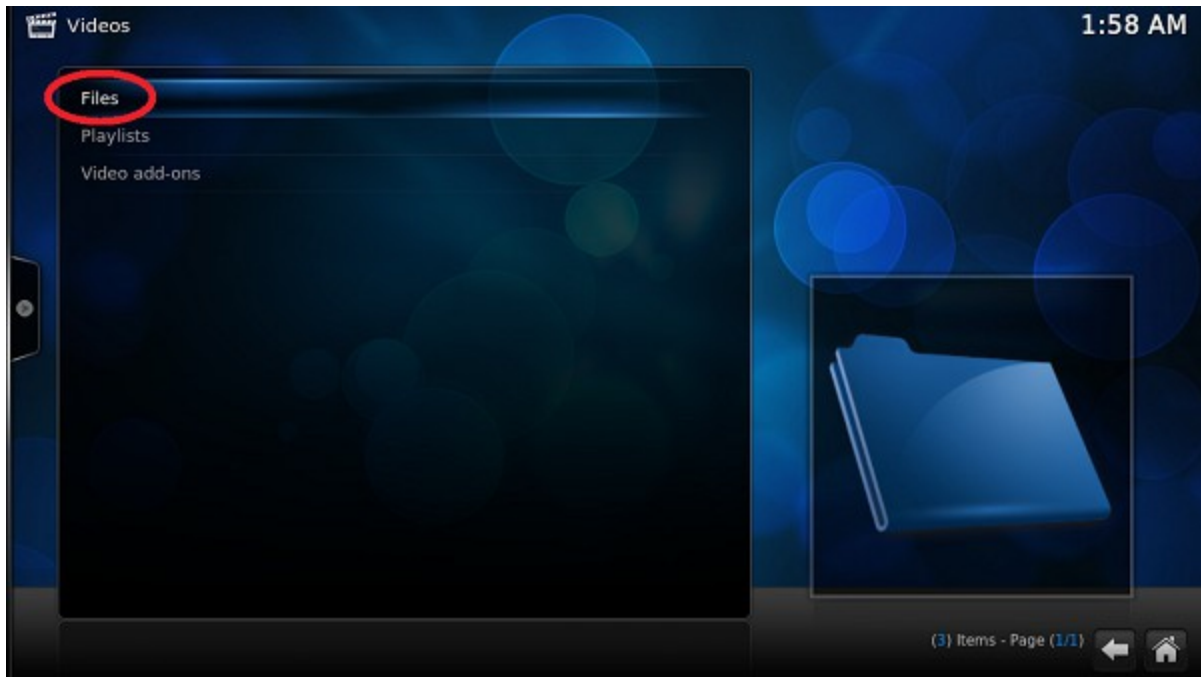
- After you had done all the setting above, manually add a network share on your Window 10 PC to RockBox.
- Select RKMC from Home screen.



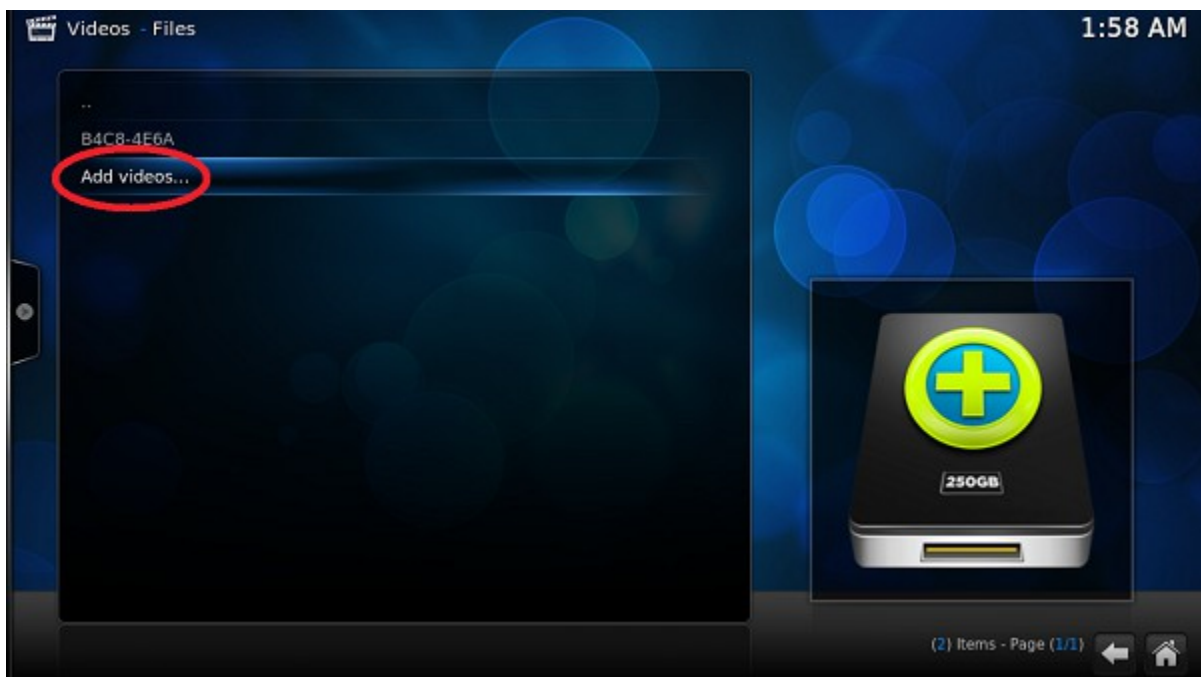
Step 6 : After access into RKMC, Select VIDEOS



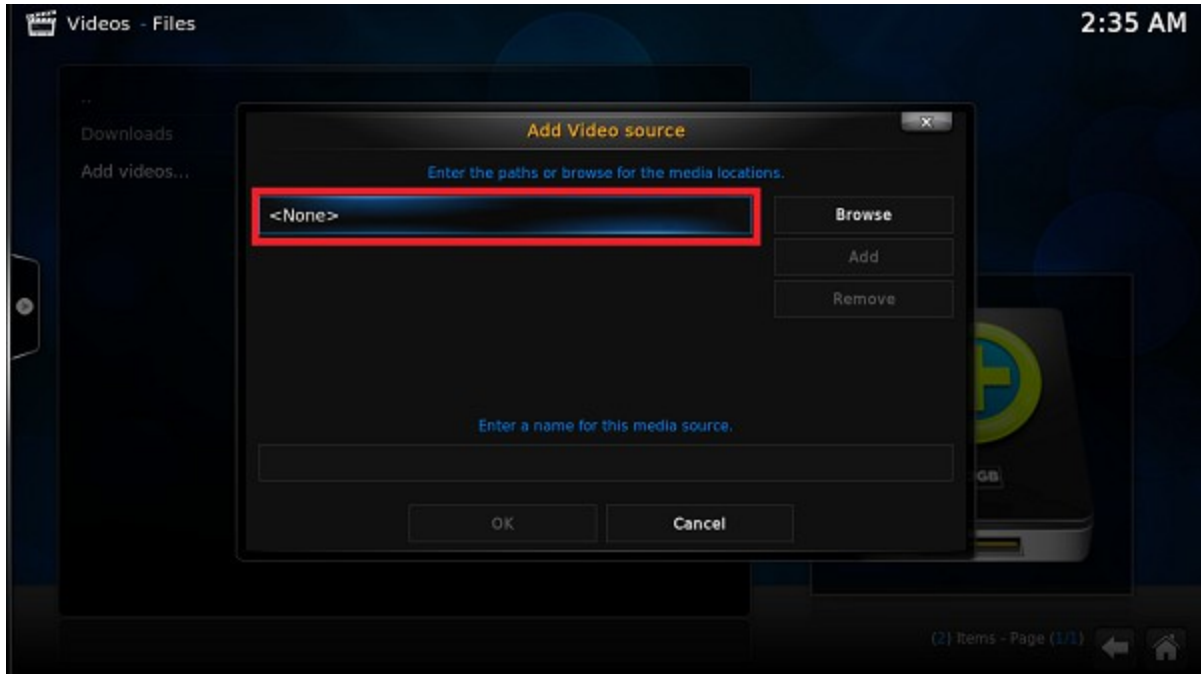
